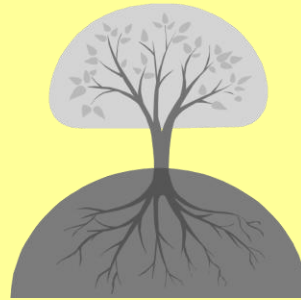

In July SV delivered a petition signed by 250 residents urging Cook County Commissioner Larry Suffredin to expedite **Crawford Avenue repairs**.

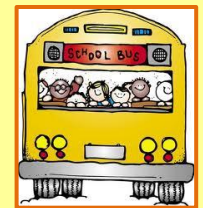
